Heavenly Father, You create us in Your own image, and
You desire that not even the least among us should per-
ish. In Your love for us, You entrusted Your only Son to
the holy Virgin Mary. Now, in Your love, protect against
the wickedness of the devil, those little ones to whom
You have given the gift of life.

THE HOLY EUCHARISTIC

1406 Jesus said: "I am the living bread that came
down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he
will live for ever; . . . he who eats my flesh and drinks
my blood has eternal life and . . . abides in me, and I
in him"

1407 The Eucharist is the heart and the summit of the
Church's life, for in it Christ associates his Church
and all her members with his sacrifice of praise and
thanksgiving offered once for all on the cross to his
Father; by this sacrifice he pours out the graces of
salvation on his Body which is the Church.

1408 The Eucharistic celebration always includes:
the proclamation of the Word of God; thanksgiving to
God the Father for all his benefits, above all the gift
of his Son; the consecration of bread and wine; and
participation in the liturgical banquet by receiving the
Lord's body and blood. These elements constitute
one single act of worship.

1409 The Eucharist is the memorial of Christ's Pass-
over, that is, of the work of salvation accomplished
by the life, death, and resurrection of Christ, a work
made present by the liturgical action.

1410 It is Christ himself, the eternal high priest of the
New Covenant who, acting through the ministry of
the priests, offers the Eucharistic sacrifice. And it is
the same Christ, really present under the species of
bread and wine, who is the offering of the Eucharistic
sacrifice.
