### ARCHDIOCESAN LENTEN REGULATIONS

**Ash Wednesday (Feb. 14) and Good Friday (Mar. 30)**  
are days of **abstinence** for all Catholics **over the age 14**.

On these two days, **fast**, as well as **abstinence**, is also  
obligatory for those **from the age of 18-59**.

Abstinence means abstinence from meat. Fast means  
one full meal a day, with two smaller meals and  
nothing between meals (liquids are permitted). No  
Catholic will lightly excuse himself or herself from this  
obligation.

**All Fridays in Lent** are days of **abstinence** from meat. If  
there is a serious health problem, this obligation  
would not apply.

### Anointing of the Sick

1527 The sacrament of Anointing of the Sick has as  
its purpose the conferral of a special grace on the  
Christian experiencing the difficulties inherent in the  
condition of grave illness or old age.

1528 The proper time for receiving this holy anoint-  
ing has certainly arrived when the believer begins to  
be in danger of death because of illness or old age.

1529 Each time a Christian falls seriously ill, he may  
receive the Anointing of the Sick, and also when, af-  
ter he has received it, the illness worsens

1532 The special grace of the sacrament of the  
Anointing of the Sick has as its effects:  
- the uniting of the sick person to the passion of  
Christ, for his own good and that of the whole  
Church;  
- the strengthening, peace, and courage to endure in  
a Christian manner the sufferings of illness or old  
age;  
- the forgiveness of sins, if the sick person was not  
able to obtain it through the sacrament of Penance;  
- the restoration of health, if it is conducive to the  
salvation of his soul;  
- the preparation for passing over to eternal life.

### Stewardship Awareness

*"Brothers and sisters, whether you eat or drink, or what-  
ever you do, do everything for the glory of God."*

1 Corinthians 10:31

Do a quick check of your priorities. Where does God  
rank in that list? If He's not first, you have some work to  
do. Putting God first in everything helps us from putting  
other "gods" (like our pride and ego, money and posses-  
sions to name a few) before God. Before making a deci-  
sion, ask yourself am I doing this for the glory of God or  
for the glory of me?
